Miss Coats gave information on the internet at Camrose and Hillside Colony, and the Homeland Security grant for duress system, testing software is being installed on the computers, and robotic challenge will be on the 23rd of January.

Mr. Wieseler presented information on head lice, teacher/staff in service on January 8, the title open house will be on January 27, Northern Electric will be here on February 18, the girls' junior high basketball games will be here on January 21st, and elementary ag class will be held once a week and the ag class rotates.

Mr. Hulscher gave information on maintenance of the two classrooms of LED lights, the new Every Student Succeeds Act, the yearbook contract is up for a three year contract, three students are taking four dual credit classes, the board reviewed information on a survey of contracted bus services, student has asked if being a page in Pierre is considered "exempt", teacher shortage is statewide, Ali Tschetter made All Conference (NEC) volleyball, Ali Tschetter is the Touchstone Scholar of the week for February 4th, and Board of Education appreciation/Recognition week is January 11-16th. The Merlin V. Hahn Scholarship has been transferred to Doland Area Foundation along with the set forth guidelines. The Governor's Budget proposal for education was given to the board members.

The current enrollment for the 2015-2016 school year is at 164 students for the district. The projected enrollment is 156 students for the 2016-2017 students, this number does not include the Hillside High School.

Action 16-078: Motion by Houghtaling, 2nd by Tschetter, to increase minimum wage position to the new rate effective January 1, 2016. The new rate will be \$8.60 per hour, this includes the substitute in the kitchen and summer custodians. All ayes.

The annual school election for Board of Education members will be held on April 12, 2016. The Doland School will have two positions of the 3 (three) year terms. Petitions may be circulated on January 29, 2016, until February 26, 2016, at 5:00 p.m.

The Board of Education was presented information of the tax levy amounts for the payable 2016 year. Information was also given on the surround schools levies.

The 2016-2017 preliminary calendar was presented to the Board of Education. The calendar will be review in February and approved in March.

The 2016-2017 preliminary budget is being started. The Board will continue to work on budget and tax levies.
